COURSE DESCRIPTION	<p>THIS COURSE WILL PROVIDE STUDENTS INSTRUCTION IN VARIOUS TOPICS RELATED TO BECOMING A FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES COMPANY OFFICER. THIS COURSE CONTAINS THIRTY TWO (32) HOURS OF LECTURES AND GROUP PROJECTS. TOPICS OF THIS TRAINING PROGRAM INCLUDE: MANAGEMENT ACTIVITIES, ANALYSES, EVALUATIONS, AND STATISTICS, POST-INCIDENT ANALYSIS AND CRITIQUE, HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGEMENT, ADMINISTRATIVE RESPONSIBILITIES, SAFETY INVESTIGATION AND ANALYSES, FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY INSPECTIONS, FIRE INVESTIGATIONS, MULTI-UNIT EMERGENCY SCENE OPERATIONS, TYPES AND FORMS OF GOVERNMENT, INTERAGENCY AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION, AND SEVERAL OTHER PERTINENT TOPICS. THE CANDIDATE WILL TAKE TWO (2) MODULE WRITTEN EXAMINATIONS CONSISTING OF TWENTY FIVE (25) MULTIPLE CHOICE QUESTIONS EACH AND SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE ALL OF THE INDIVIDUAL HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENTS AND GROUP PROJECTS. <i>100% COURSE ATTENDANCE REQUIRED FOR CERTIFICATION!</i></p>
