The regularly scheduled meeting of the Frederick County CPPC Executive Committee on October 11, 2010 has been cancelled.

Update

The following is provided to the CPPC Executive Committee by way of a brief update. The ongoing efforts of various groups associated with the CPPC Executive Committee have been in full gear over the past several weeks.

- The work on the 2010 Comprehensive Plan Update continues as the next phase, which involves the coordinated compilation and writing of the Working Group Chapters into one Comprehensive Plan document, is in full swing with the Planning Commission Chairman leading this effort. The Business Development Working Group is finalizing the coordination of their Chapter. Several Chapters have been forwarded to the Board for their information and feedback. Following this, the next goal in this effort is to present the compiled plan to the general public. The timing of this public part of the process has been adjusted and is anticipated to occur in December.
- The Board of Supervisors approved the 2010 NELUP Update on September 22, 2010.
- The CPPA #01-01 for Tasker Woods, previously recommended for further study by the Board of Supervisors, continues through the planning process. Following the CPPC's work, the Planning Commission recommended that the amendment as presented by the CPPC be moved forward to a Public Hearing at their October 6, 2010 meeting.
- The draft CIP departmental project requests are due back to Planning on October 15, 2010. It is anticipated that the CPPC will review the draft CIP at your November meeting.
